

Emerald Bay, Lake Tahoe - One of the most photographed places in the world!

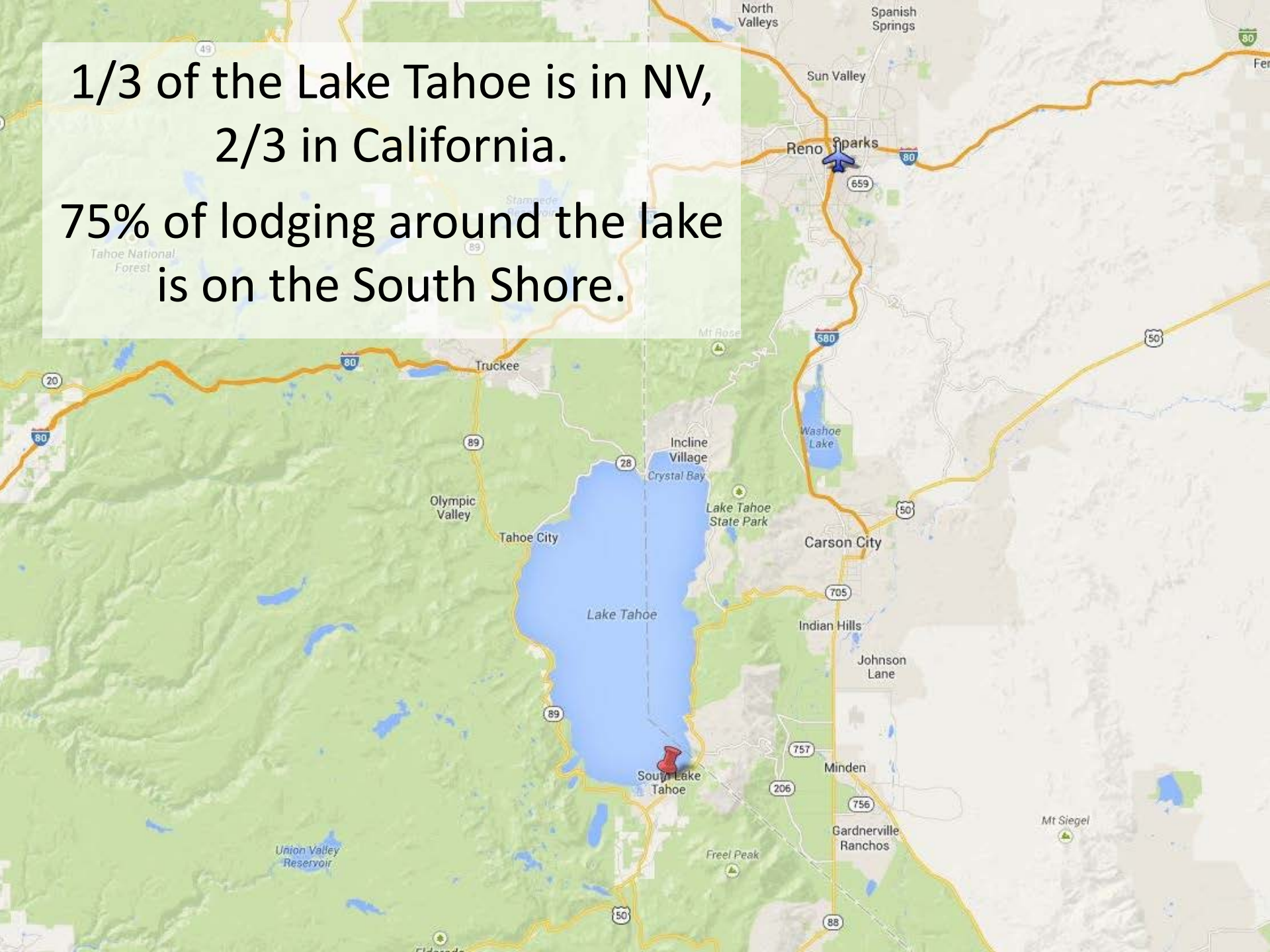
